#### Lemsford Fete display 2019

Andy asked Mary to update the Group about the 'Churchyard Tour'. Marys reported as follows:

I think we probably need about 20 sites, which we can mark with a laminated coloured A4 sheet on which there is a bold headline - such a CHORISTER FOR 60 YEARS or COMMONWEALTH WAR GRAVE for instance, and then a brief bit about the person and with a bit of luck a photograph. We could attach the sheets to bamboo canes which we stick by the grave. Then we could have a loose-leaf file with more details which can be consulted in the Hall. I would suggest that we give guided tours of the churchyards and the files would provide the necessary details for the guides.

We would also need to have a big copy of the plan of the graves in the churchyards so we can direct relatives to graves where there is no headstone. We might even have small bunches of flowers (for a small fee) which the relative could place on the grave.
